Q: Where do I go to purchase or rent Barefoot Bay residential property?

A: All residential property in Barefoot Bay Recreation District is privately owned. The Barefoot Bay Recreation District does not advertise rentals. For more information, please contact a local realtor.

Q: Does Barefoot Bay have a Homeowner's Association?

A: Barefoot Bay does not have a Homeowner's Association, but there is an annual assessment collected by Brevard County with your property taxes that funds the Barefoot Bay Recreation District. New homeowners pay a one-time Social Membership fee that assigns a non-transferable Homeowner's badge for access to Barefoot Bay amenities. Daily, weekly, monthly and annual passes are also available for visitors and renters.

How do I pay my yearly assessment fee?

A: Barefoot Bay's yearly assessment fee is paid through a resident's property taxes.

Q: What are some of the activities offered in Barefoot Bay?

A: Fishing, swimming, golf, tennis, pickle ball, bocce, handball and shuffleboard courts, horseshoes, lawn bowling, softball, billiards eateries and live entertainment.
